<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ensure necessary PPE is being used. 2. Wrap banding around the material to be secured. 3. Overlap the banding and apply the tightener. 4. Tighten the banding until the material is secure by using half strokes of the tightening lever. 5. Apply the fastening clip. 6. Crimp the clip in place. 7. Cut off excess banding. 8. Ensure access banding or material is removed to prevent tripping hazards. 9. REPORT ANY DANGEROUS SITUATIONS TO THE SUPERVISOR.
