- Avoid making or accepting cell phone calls while driving unless you have a HAND-FREE DEVICE.
- 2. Pull onto the shoulder or a parking lot & take or make the call.
- 3. Never text or read texts while driving.
- 4. Have a voice mail option to pick up messages.
- 5. Have passengers answer or make calls.
- 6. Do not engage in stressful or emotional conversations when driving.
- 7. Avoid taking notes or looking up phone numbers while driving.
- 8. Pause hands free conversations if driving conditions become hazardous (e.g., weather, construction, traffic)
- 9. Ensure cell phones are turned off during refueling to avoid static electricity coming in contact with gas fumes, especially in hot weather.
- 10. EXCEPTION: a person may use a hand operated electronic device to make an emergency call to police, fire department or ambulance.
- 11. Anyone charged by police for using an electronic device, other than hands free, while driving will be subject to a fine.
- 12. Any J&G Homes Ltd, J&G Supply Ltd or VBJ Developments Ltd employee who is subjected to a fine for a cell phone infraction while operating a company vehicle will be responsible to cover the cost of the fine.
- 13. Any further charges laid (e.g. results of an accident) do to cell phone or electronic device usage while in a company vehicle will also be the operator's sole responsibility.
