<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ensure that the truck and trailer are on level ground and braking system is engaged. 2. Hoist box in air. 3. Driver to exit truck, walk at least 20' at an angle from the driver's side front corner of the truck to a safe distance. 4. Have a Hoe Excavator operator ensure there is a bucket with flat teeth or a cleanup bucket in place. 5. Hoe Excavator operator will clean out the box of the End Dump and then move back away from the trailer to the Truck Driver can inspect the box and make sure it is to his satisfaction. 6. Once the box is clean lower the hoist. 7. If utilizing a water pressure hose, raise the box completely, open the end gate, stand at the rear of the trailer and wash the trailer out with the pressure hose until clean.
