TITLE	Cleaning Solvents & Flammables
GENERAL	Protect the worker against hazards which may be created from the use of these materials.
APPLICATION	Cleaning solvents and flammables are used in the day to day operations to clean tools and equipment.
PROTECTIVE MECHANISMS	Safe work Procedure WHMIS MSDS
SELECTION AND USE	As per safe work procedure
SUPERVISOR RESPONSIBILITY	Supervisors are responsible to facilitate and/or provide proper instruction and training to their workers.
WORKER RESPONSIBILITY	 Use non-flammable solvents for cleaning whenever possible. When flammable liquids are used, make sure that no hot work is permitted in the area and ensure appropriate safeguards are used to prevent fire/explosion. Store flammables and solvents in special, appropriately marked storage area. Check MSDS, for specific hazards and uses associated with the solvent to be used. Provide proper ventilation or use respiratory protection. Wear protective clothing. Never leave solvents in open containers and return to proper storage containers.
