- 1. Fill Tanks in well vented areas outside.
- 2. Store all decanted diesel outdoors.
- 3. Label all decanted containers as per WHMIS.
- 4. Extinguish all flames, sparks, cigarettes. Do not use cell phones.
- 5. Turn off engine before filling equipment or slip tanks.
- 6. Use Genuine spill proof gas containers to transport fuel.
- 7. Wash hands thoroughly after handling.
- 8. Avoid inhaling fumes.
- 9. Clean up spills immediately using spill kit.
