1. Perform a hazard assessment of the job.

Equipment Failure

- 2. Determine what equipment will be needed (fall arrest, fall restrain, nets, guardrails)
- 3. Read and understand manufacturers instructions.
- 4. Inspect all equipment or guard rails before use.
- 5. Tag out and remove defective equipment from use.
- 6. Don equipment and inspect for proper fit as per training or as advised by competent worker.
- 7. Set up safety lines and anchor points as required before commencing work.
- 8. Hook to safety line.
- 9. Ensure retractors and rope grabs are working properly.
- 10. Be aware of all open edges in your working area.
- 11. When finished task, leave the danger area and unhook from the safety line.
- 12. When finished store the equipment in a dry, ventilated area. Hang harnesses.
