<div>1. Remove applicable extinguisher from hanger</div> <div>2. Carry extinguisher in upright position to fire</div> <div>3. Pull pin of extinguisher, hold hose or horn in one hand</div> <div>4. Pull the trigger, aiming at base of fire, squeeze the handle and use a sweeping motion</div> <div>5. Report the use of extinguisher</div> <div>6. Take the extinguisher out of service and have it re-charged.</div>
