- 1. Remove applicable extinguisher from hanger
- 2. Carry extinguisher in upright position to fire
- 3. Pull pin of extinguisher, hold hose or horn in one hand
- 4. Pull the trigger, aiming at base of fire, squeeze the handle and use a sweeping motion
- 5. Report the use of extinguisher
- 6. Take the extinguisher out of service and have it re-charged.
