Arrange with your supervisor. for lunch breaks, washroom and coffee breaks. 5. Always be visible to oncoming traffic. Do not sit in a vehicle. 6. Do not read or listen to music devices, i.e. mp3 players. 7. Use of cellular devices is not allowed in any way.
