- 1. Fill tanks in well ventilated area or outside.
- 2. Store all decanted gasoline outdoors.
- 3. Label all decanted containers as per WHMIS.
- 4. Extinguish all flames, sparks and cigarettes. Do not use cell phone.
- 5. Turn off engine before filling equipment or slip tanks.
- 6. Use genuine spill proof gas containers
- 7. Wash hands thoroughly after handling
- 8. Avoid inhaling fumes
- 9. Clean up spills immediately using a spill kit.
