- 1. Operate truck according to Semi & Tandem Truck Operating Procedure.
- 2. Check operation of end dump, gate & hoist.
- 3. Proceed to loading area.
- 4. Put truck in park.
- 5. Stay in truck while being loaded, keep an eye on load in rear-view.
- 6. Wait for signal from loader before moving from loading area.
- 7. Ensure truck is not overloaded.
- 8. Tarp load.
- 9. Proceed to dump area, obey all traffic regulation on way.
- 10. Dump according to Unloading Granular Procedure.
