- 1. Try to have a path for drivers in a way to keep backing up to a minimum.
- 2. Scoop up bucket of material to desired amount.
- 3. Be sure truck is stopped before loading.
- 4. Pull up to side of truck box and dump load.
- 5. Repeat and fill box to desired amount, ensure not to overload.
- 6. Signal driver to proceed.
- 7. Clean up and granular that was spilled.
