- 1. Position mixer truck in designated wash area and ensure park brake is set and operating properly.
- 2. Idle truck engine with drum rotating slowly.
- 3. Apply truck washing chemical to rotating drum, avoiding direct contact with decaling and allow to soak for a short period of time.
- 4. Thoroughly rinse chemical from drum.
- 5. Repeat if necessary.
- 6. Place drum in neutral and shut off truck engine.
- 7. Apply truck wash chemical to rear of truck (fenders, Rims, Chutes, Hopper, etc...
- 8. Allow to soak.
- 9. Rinse thoroughly.
- 10. Repeat if necessary.
