- 1. Engage hazard signals.
- 2. If truck placement is not immediately obvious, preform a walk through to check clearances and to familiarize with the job requirements, paying special attention to front, back, side and overhead hazards.
- 3. Ensure back-up beeper is in operation.
- 4. Clean windows and mirrors if required align mirrors to enable maximum view to rear of truck.
- 5. All truck movements are to be made slowly.
- 6. Use a spotter whenever possible when moving a truck (forward or back)
- 7. Ensure that spotter understands appropriate hand and voice signals needed to facilitate communication.
- 8. If sight or eye contact with spotter is lost at any time, STOP immediately and reestablish contact before proceeding.
- 9. Be aware of your surroundings at all times. Distractions can lead to serious consequences.
