- 1. Clean boots of mud or ice before climbing into machine or truck.
- 2. Using grab rail and facing the machine/truck, step onto the first step.
- 3. Maintain 3-point contact always (two hands and one foot, or one hand and two feet)

4. Climb into cab.

Pinch points

- 5. To climb off machine/truck, make sure the machine is on level ground and brakes are set.
- 6. Step out of cab onto ladder and while facing the machine descend using the 3- point method.
- 7. Do not jump from the machine/truck or get off while it is in motion.
- 8. Be extra cautious under wet or icy conditions.
- 9. Do not allow anyone to ride outside of machines/trucks.
