- 2. Store all oil away from direct sparks or flame.
- 3. Practice good housekeeping, to prevent slipping.
- 4. Use absorb all to clean up spills from floor.
- 5. Turn off engines before adding oil.
- 6. Tag and lockout all equipment while changing oil.
