<p>Pre-Mixing:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Read and understand safety labels and instructions. 2. Check area for housekeeping. Remove clutter or spills. 3. Check mixer for visible signs of wear. 4. Report any concerns to supervisor. Do not use. 5. Alert others in the area that the mixer is being used. 6. No customers allowed in shaking area. 7. Know location of Emergency Shutoff <p>Operating Mixer</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Open mixer door 2. Place container(s) near centre of the table. If mixing two cans ensure they are the same height. 3. If using a 5 gallon container place the small foam pad on top of the container and even with the rim. 4. Close the door firmly and push START. Mixing time is pre-set. 5. Wait for full shaking to stop. 6. Open door and remove containers. 7. Do not use plastic containers in paint mixer. 8. If mixer becomes noisy during operation, shut off power, reposition containers and retighten lids then restart. 9. REPORT ANY DANGEROUS SITUATIONS TO THE SUPERVISOR
