<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Ensure proper size of respirator for the worker. 2. Ensure the proper cartridge for the job. E.g. Organic, dust, gases. 3. Inspect the respirator before each use. 4. The respirator must be worn as specified in the supplier's manual. 5. Employee must be trained in proper donning and fit test. 6. Cartridge must be changed as soon as odor is detected. 7. Clean the respirator with soap and water or alcohol after each use as per manufacturers instructions. 8. Store the respirator in a dust proof container.
