WORKER RESPONSIBILITY	 Safety Do's: Designate a signal person and ensure they and the operator understand the signals. The equipment operator must remain at the controls of his machine whenever a load is on the hook. Make sure the area is blocked off and all workers are clear of area before lifting. Keep hands clear of pinch points. Ensure load is placed on level stable ground. Tag lines are to be used to guide loads. Keep a minimum of 2 meters clearance between load and adjacent roadways or railways unless provisions have been made. Safety Don't's: Stand under a load or between a load and other objects. Move a load with other workers in the area. Land a heavy load on an existing structure. Perform rigging operations unless properly trained.
