<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Read and understand the manufacturers manual before operating.</li> <li>2. Read all decals and stencils on the machine.</li> <li>3. Check battery for water level and charge daily.</li> <li>4. Complete a pre-op inspection before each use.</li> <li>5. Do not use the machine if deficiencies are discovered.</li> <li>6. Distribute loads evenly on the platform; do not exceed load capacity or overhang the platform.</li> <li>7. Hang control box on the guardrail or in position before connecting plug.</li> <li>8. Do not lay lift control on platform as accidental activation may occur.</li> <li>9. Check for possible obstructions around and above machine before operating. Always clear the area before moving vertically or horizontally.</li> <li>10. Fall protection must be worn when moving the lift (horizontally).</li> <li>11. Ride on lift when it is moving. If it is not possible then walk beside the machine – never walk in front of or behind the machine.</li> <li>12. Secure loads before moving machine.</li> <li>13. Do not alter the height with scaffolds or ladders on the platform.</li> <li>14. Do not tow the machine. For longer distances move by truck or trailer.</li> <li>15. Do not work under or perform maintenance on lift while in the raised position unless the safety bar is in position.</li> <li>16. <b>REPORT ANY DANGEROUS SITUATIONS TO THE SUPERVISOR.</b></li> </ol>
