- 1. Park vehicle/machine on level ground free of debris.
- 2. Lock out machine/vehicle.
- 3. Ensure all tools are on hand.
- 4. Ensure applicable brakes are applied.
- 5. Place blocks behind wheels.
- 4. Hoist vehicle using proper method.
- 5. Place supports such as:
- A. Vehicle Support Stands
- B. Wood Fabricated Stands
- C. Automotive Hoists
- 6. Cautiously proceed under the vehicle using a creeper if possible.
- 7. Perform work.
- 8. Clean up area when finished.
- 9. Remove supports and lower vehicle/machine.
