<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Only properly trained workers are to operate any powered mobile equipment.</li> <li>2. Training shall be performed by a qualified and competent trainer.</li> <li>3. Put on PPE before beginning the task and ensure proper fit.</li> <li>4. Make sure the owner's manual is in the equipment and refer to it as necessary.</li> <li>5. Inspect work area and equipment before beginning. A complete visual inspection of the equipment and surrounding area will be made to ensure that it is in safe operating condition and that no one, including the operator, will be endangered when the powered mobile equipment is started. Report any deficiencies to the site foreman.</li> <li>6. Deficiencies must be corrected before operation of any powered mobile equipment.</li> <li>7. A written record of all inspections, maintenance and repairs to the powered mobile equipment is to be kept at the workplace and be readily available to the operator.</li> <li>8. When using scissor lift or man basket, all occupants must use proper fall arrest (full body harness with lanyard connected to an approved anchor point).</li> <li>9. Seatbelts are to be worn where applicable.</li> <li>10. Ensure adequate ventilation when operating powered equipment in spaces where air quality may be a concern.</li> <li>11. Loads shall not exceed any manufacturer's load rating on any equipment or connection.</li> <li>12. Tire servicing shall be done by a qualified individual in accordance with the manufacturer's specifications of both the tire and the powered mobile equipment.</li> </ol> <p style="text-align: center;">If An Emergency Situation Occurs - STOP – Follow The Instructions Of The Foreman Or their Designate.</p>
